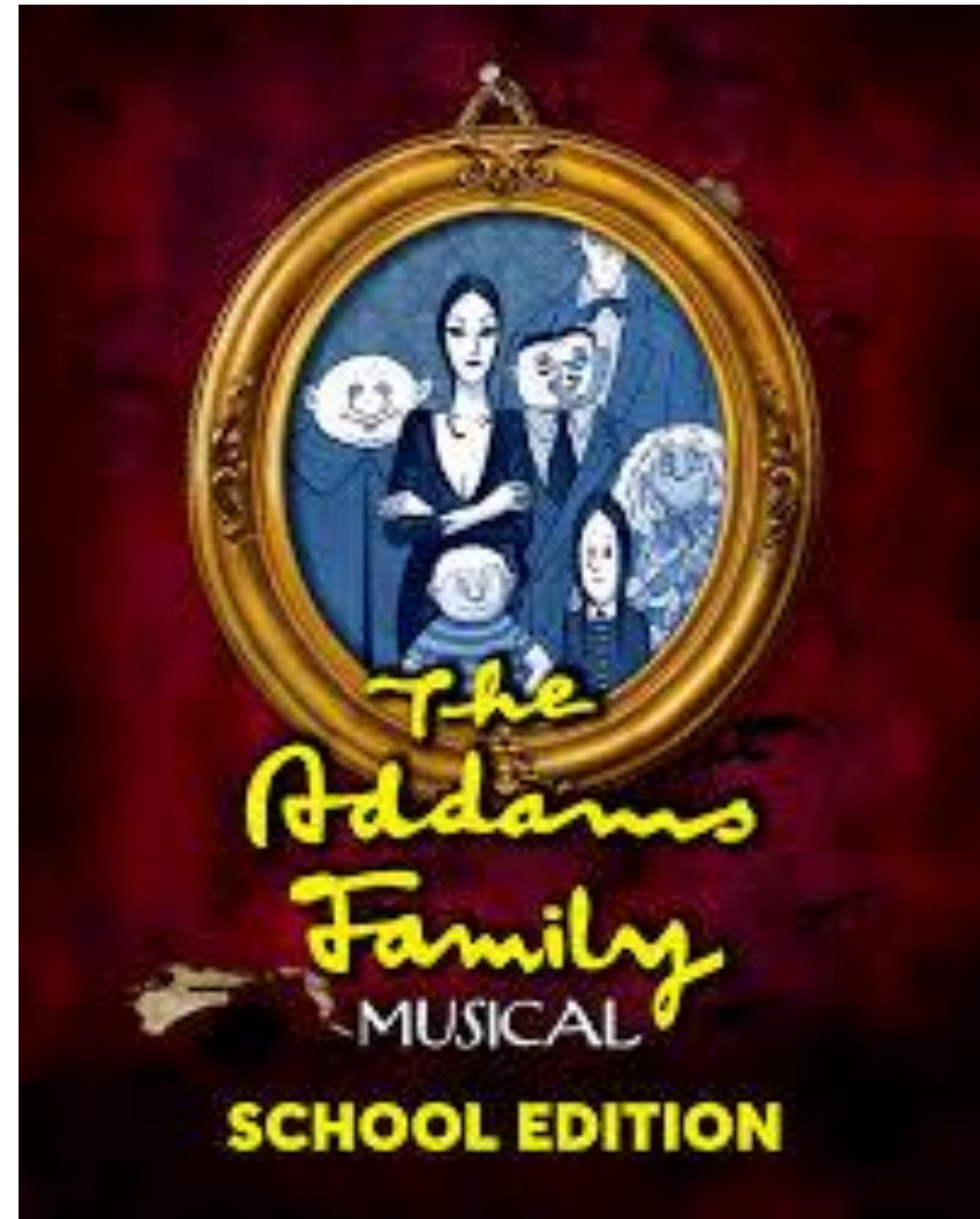

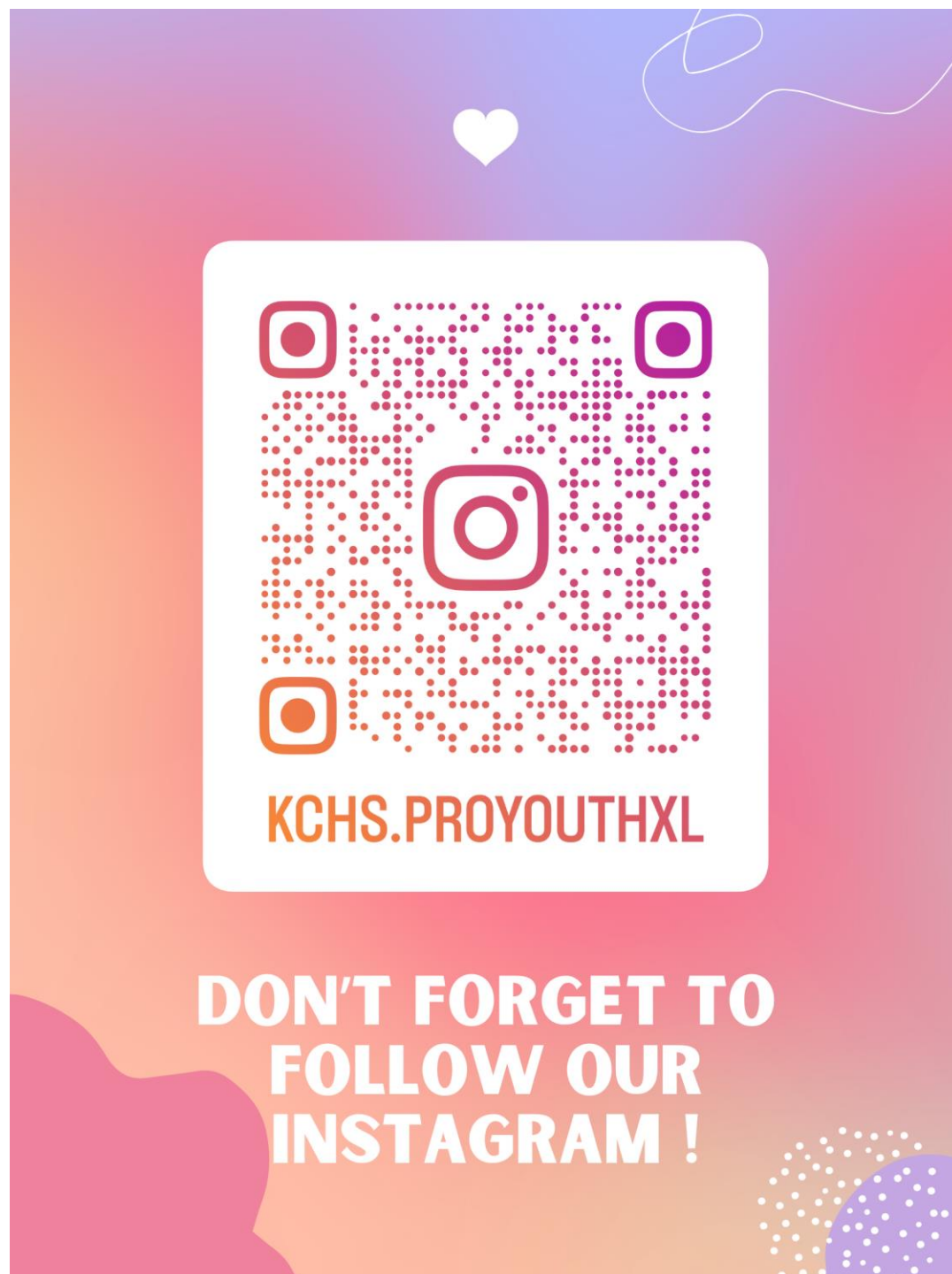
KING CITY HIGH SCHOOL NEWSPAPER
